Kansas now offering digital fingerprinting for insurance agent applicants

Topeka, Kan. - Today, the Kansas Insurance Department, under the leadership of Insurance Commissioner Vicki Schmidt and in partnership with Pearson VUE, announced digital fingerprinting services are now available at Pearson VUE testing centers in Overland Park, Topeka, and Wichita for insurance agent applicants.

“When COVID hit, the Kansas Insurance Department was the first in the nation to get producer licensing exam facilities reopened and get Kansans back to work,” Insurance Commissioner Vicki Schmidt said. “We were also one of the first states to implement online testing for applicants. Digital fingerprinting adds an additional level of convenience for applicants and helps the Department further streamline the licensing process.”
