As a result of the catastrophic damaged caused in the ice and snow storm affecting much of northwest Oregon, Oregon's Insurance Commissioner will be accepting applications for temporary adjuster permits for the next 30 days. Applications can be submitted online through NIPR.com by any person authorized to act as an adjuster in another state and who is asked by an authorized insurer to adjust losses in the catastrophe area. Temporary adjuster permits are valid for 90 days and may not be renewed. Oregon does not charge for the temporary adjuster permits but NIPR may charge a small user fee.
